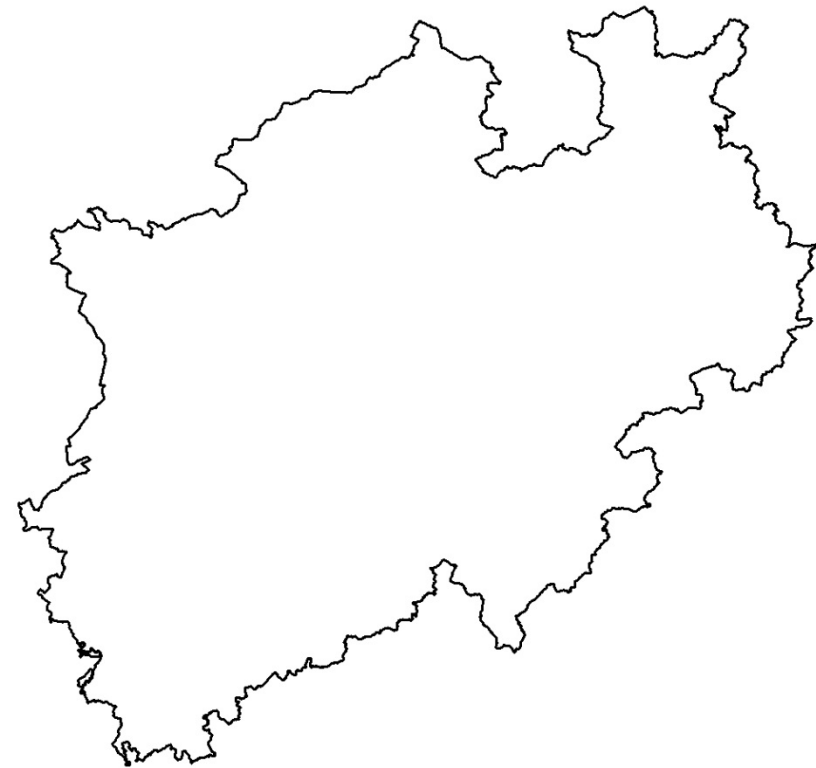

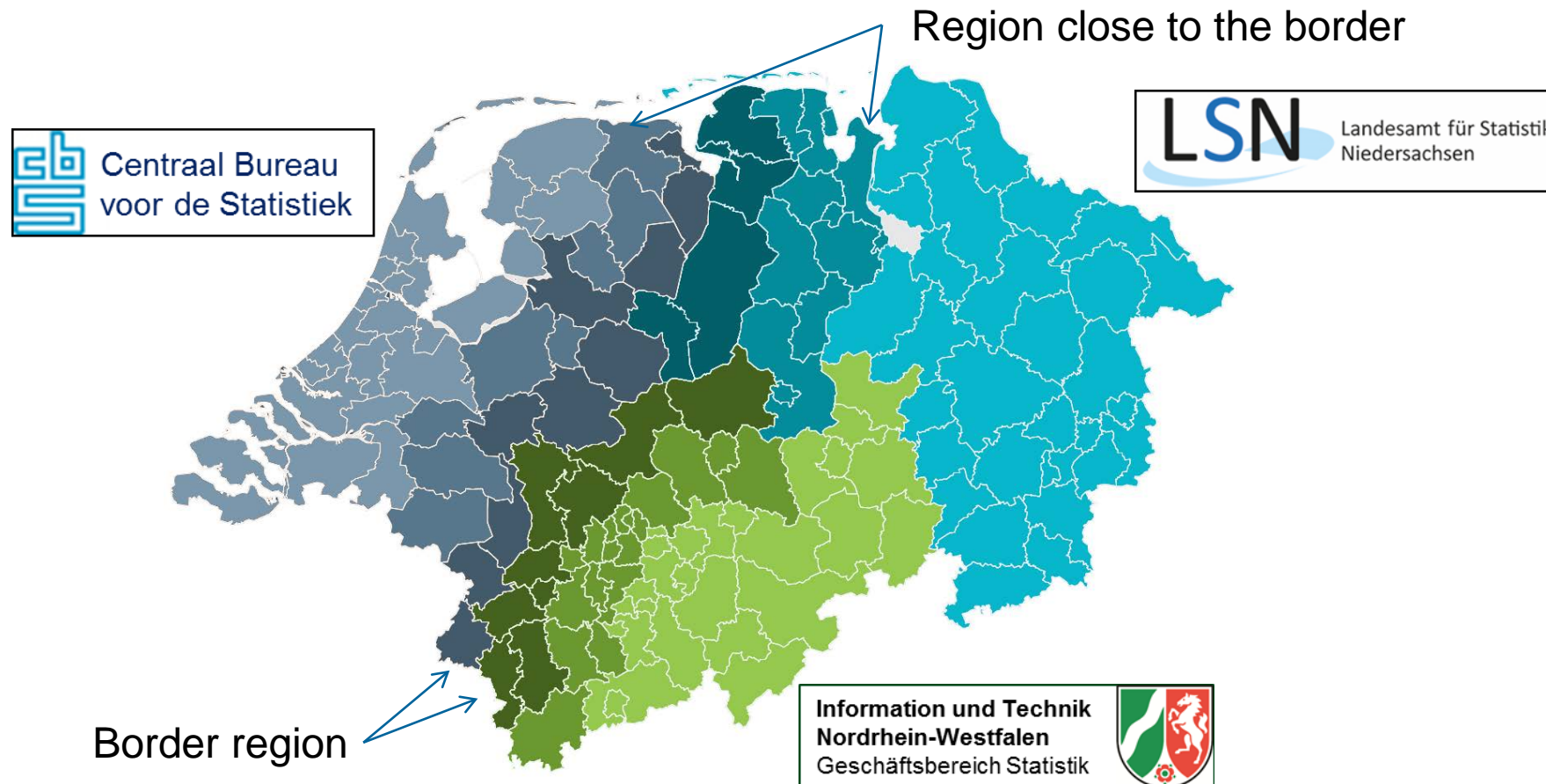


Labour market in border regions: The Netherlands – Germany

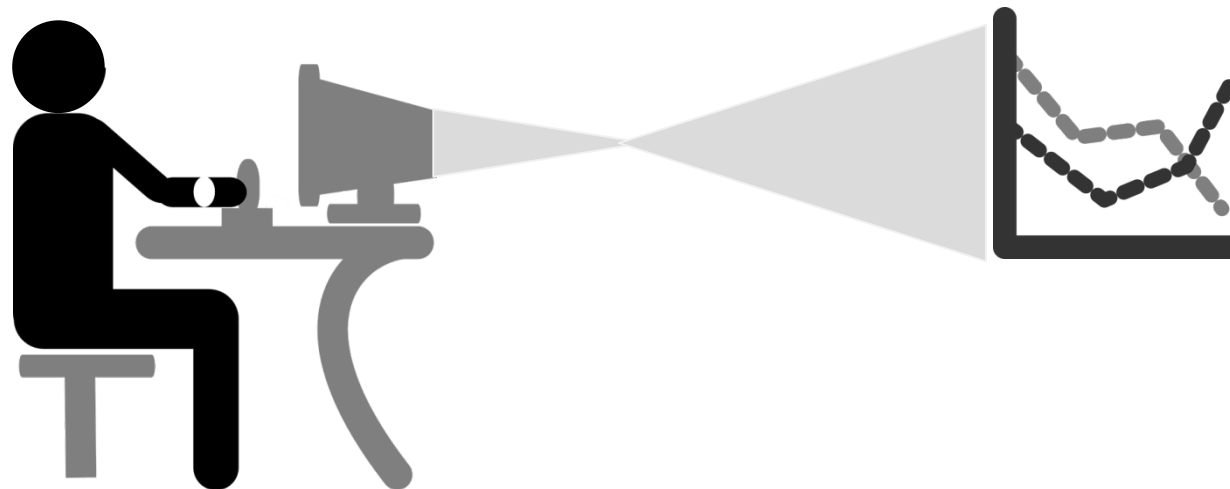


Goals:

- Data updates at least till 2024

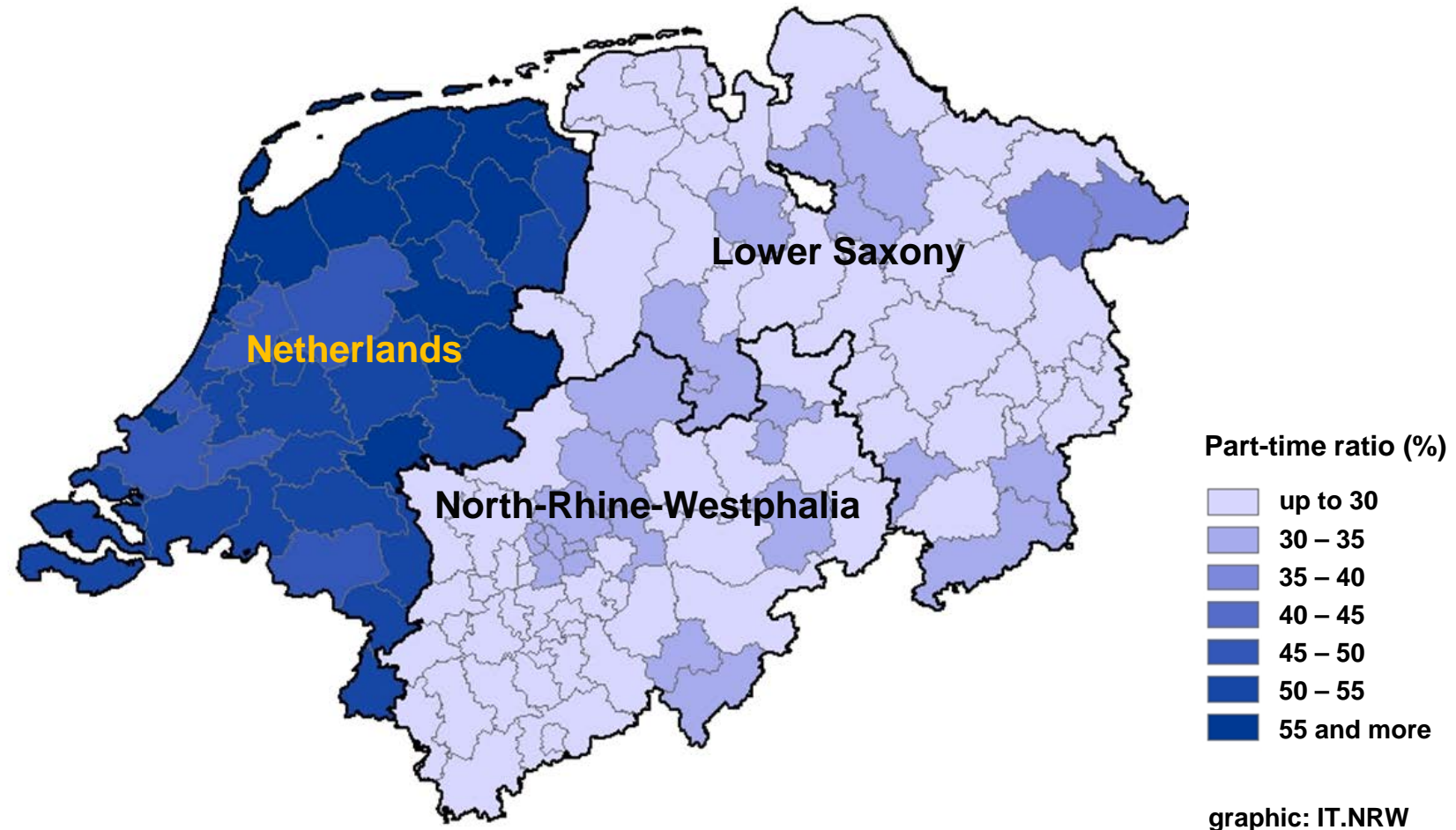

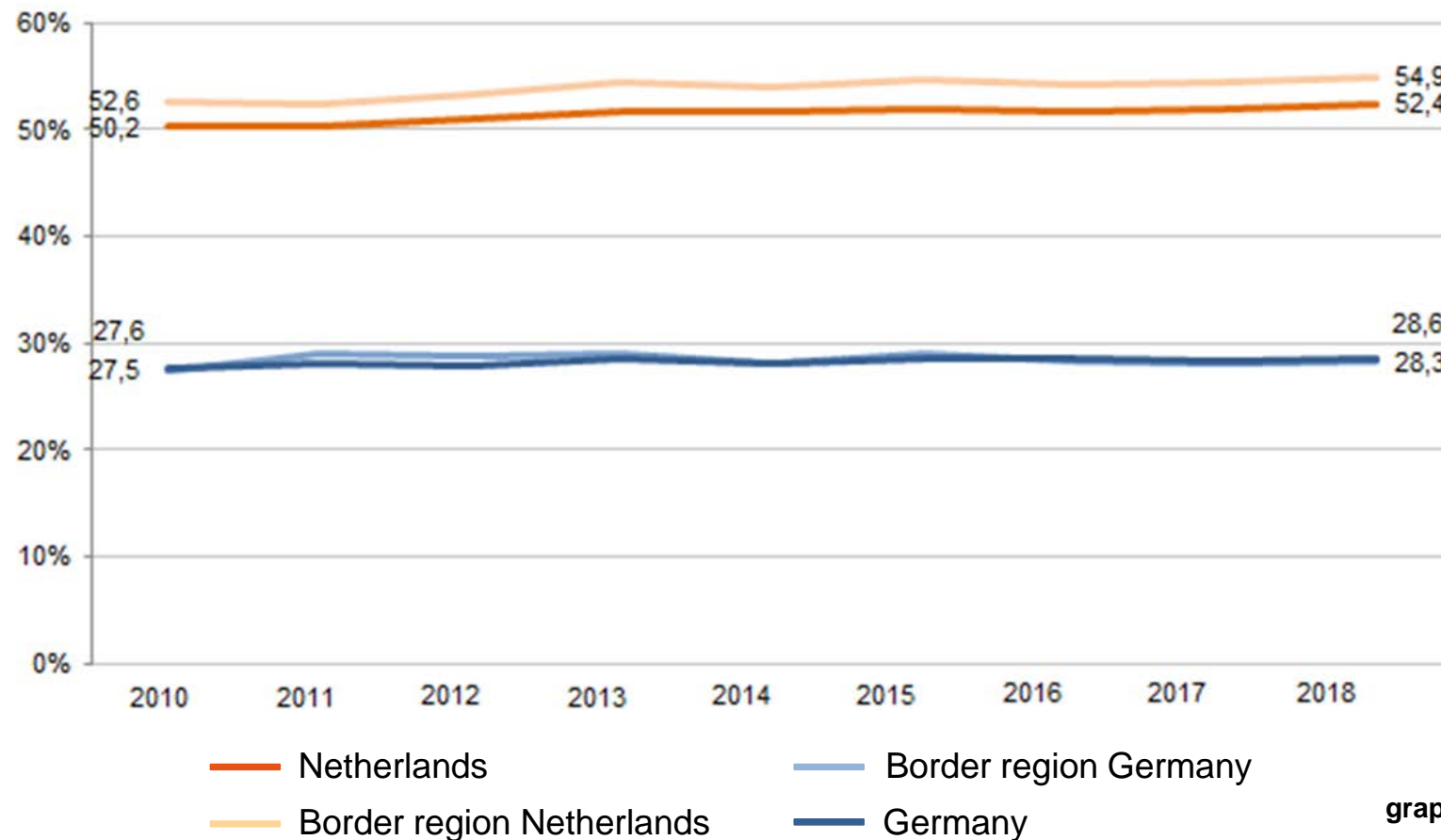


Part-time employment rate 2018





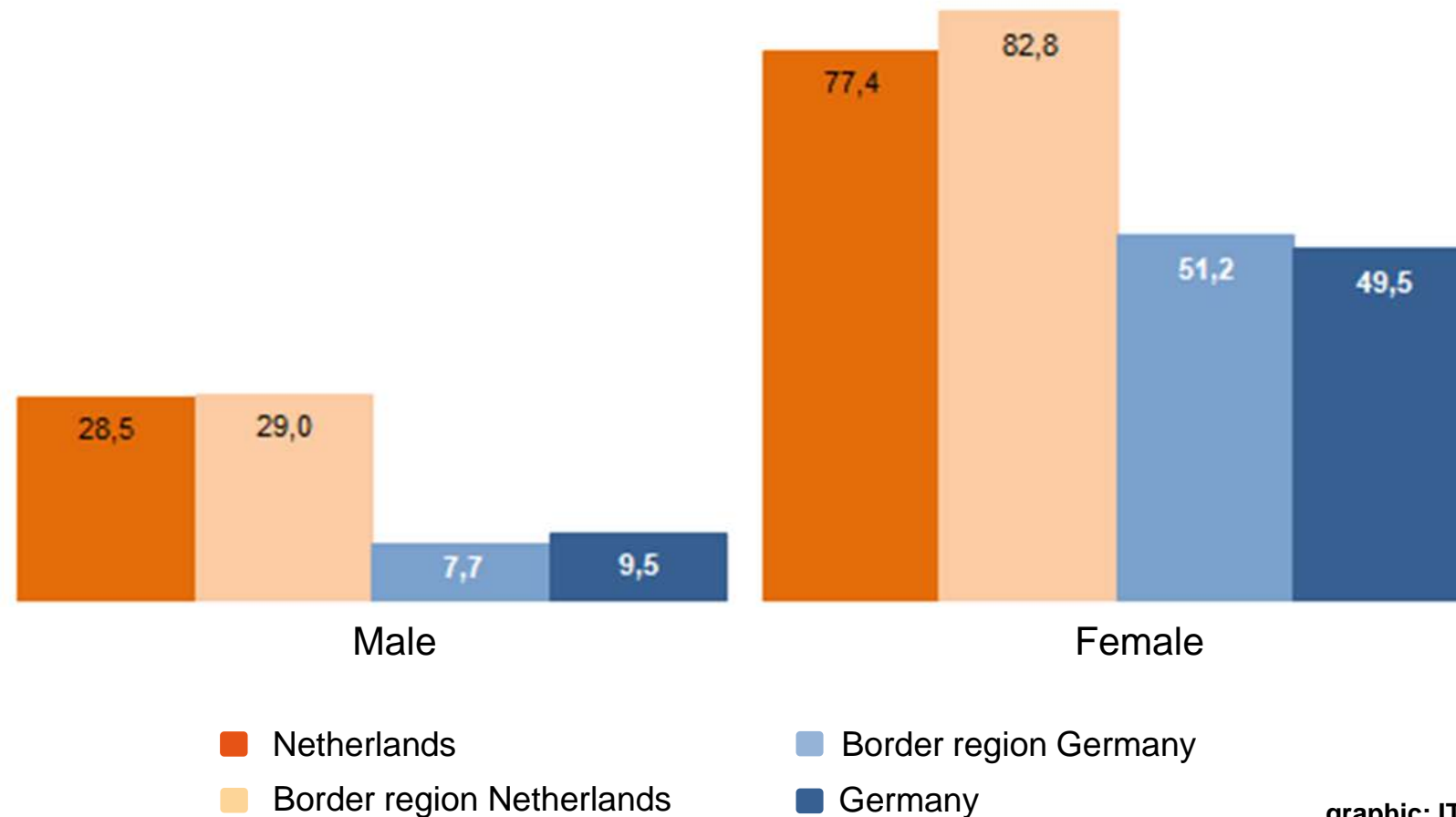
Part-time employment rates from 2010 to 2018 in the border regions of Germany and the Netherlands

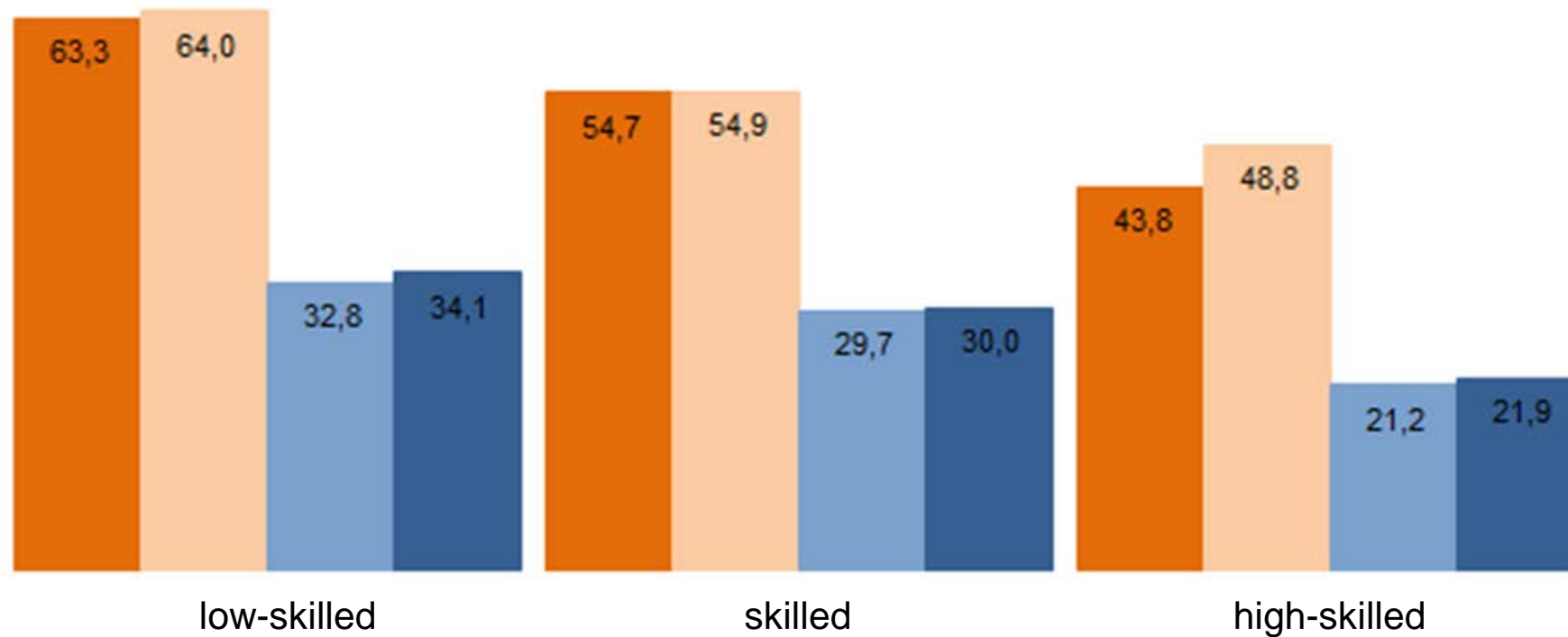
Part-time employment rate 2018 by gender

Key Results:

- The German and the Dutch labour market differs considerably.
- The border regions hardly deviate from the respective national values. Labour market conditions in the border regions of Germany and The Netherlands differ considerably.
- Clear differences can be seen between population groups.
